COVID-19 information for Parents – from 1 September 2022

1. If have symptoms

If symptoms are mild (e.g. runny nose, sore throat or slight cough) and they are otherwise well, they can continue to attend school.

Stay at home if they have a high temperature or feel unwell. Avoid contact with other people until they are well enough to return to school and no longer have a high temperature.

2. If pupils test positive with LFD or PCR

It is not recommended that children and young people aged 18 years and under are tested for COVID-19 unless directed to by a health professional. If a student has a positive COVID-19 test result they should stay at home and avoid contact with other people for **3 days** (after the day they took the test). After 3 days, if they feel well and do not have a high temperature, they can return to school.

3. Hand and respiratory hygiene on site

All pupils and staff are encouraged to continue to practice good hygiene: regular washing of hands (the hand sanitiser stations remain in place around the school site); covering coughs and sneezes ('catch it, bin it, kill it').

7. Covid risk assessments

The DfE guidance on Risk Assessment for Covid-19 was withdrawn on 1 April 2022. Where appropriate, COVID-19 specific guidance will be removed from policy documentation (and associated procedures) as part of our annual review of policies for September 2022.

9. Mask wearing

Staff and pupils are not required to wear a mask on the school site and masks are actively discouraged in lessons. In line with TfL guidance, individuals can decide to wear a face covering on school transport if it helps them travel with confidence.

10. Remote learning

If a pupil tests positive for COVID-19, but is well enough to work, the pupil's teacher will coordinate with all relevant teachers in order to provide work on Teams.
