## **Appearance Regulations and Uniform Lists**

All students should be aware that the School expects high standards of appearance at all times. These regulations apply throughout the school day, including when travelling to and from school. The School operates a uniform service through Perry uniform (<a href="https://www.perryuniform.co.uk">www.perryuniform.co.uk</a>). Items marked with a \* must be purchased.

## Please note that all clothes MUST be properly labelled.

### Boys (Years 7 – 11)

- Navy/royal stripe suit jacket\*
- Navy/royal stripe suit trousers\*
- Plain white long-sleeved shirt\*
- V-neck school pullover\*
- School tie\*
- Plain navy socks
- Clean, polished, black leather business style shoes
- Black, navy or dark grey coat (optional)

#### **Girls (Years 7 – 11)**

- Navy/royal stripe suit jacket\*
- Navy/royal stripe suit skirt\*
- Navy/royal stripe suit trousers
- White long sleeve blouse\*
- V-necked school pullover\*
- Navy/gold formal scarf\*
- Dark blue/black tights or dark blue ankle socks
- Clean, polished, black leather business style shoes
- Black, navy or dark grey coat (optional)

#### Sixth Form (Years 12 and 13)

- A formal trouser suit, dress (worn with jacket) or skirt suit which are of business style and a conservative cut
- Formal knitwear can be worn under a jacket

### General points relating to appearance

#### **Jewellery**

One pair of small studs or hoops are permitted as is a simple religious symbol on a plain necklace.

#### Hair

Should be clean and natural in colour. Hair touching the shoulders must be tied up.

## Make Up

Make Up should be kept to a minimum and be natural in appearance. Acrylic nails and nail polish are not permitted, and students will be asked to remove them.

#### Hot weather

During periods warm weather, students will be allowed to remove their blazers and roll up their sleeves. The final decision will be made by the DHP

The Deputy Head Pastoral's decision about whether any form of dress is acceptable is final. Students will be warned if their dress is not appropriate, repeated failure to adhere to these guidelines will result in a sanction.

### Games Kit (Years 7 – 11)

The following games kit items are compulsory to purchase. There are a number of additional items which students may wish to have depending on the particular sports they participate in over the course of the academic year.

Mouthguards and shin pads are mandatory. One padlock is required for each Year 7 student's locker. This must be bought into school on the first day.
